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EVACUATION:

You should have a leash, collar, and/or crate or carrier for each animal. Label each item for the pet to which it is assigned. Store these items with your Pet Disaster Go Kit. Determine in advance how you will assemble your pet(s) to evacuate and your means of transportation.

Plan for appropriate lodging in advance – this may be staying with a friend, a family member, or in a pet friendly hotel/motel. List your lodging options in the table below. At least one of your options should be located outside of your community in case the entire area is impacted.
